I. God’s Power over our Enemies (v. 1)

- A.) Testimony preceded them unto their enemies
- B.) Their enemies hearts and desire to fight taken away
- C.) The favor of God was upon them

II. God’s Plan for those who are Obedient and Disobedient(v. 2-9)

- A.) Circumcision Spiritual application
- B.) Certification on God’s man He was with Him and they were with Him
- C.) Casualty of doubt, fear, apathy and disobedience
(“Will a people have to die off before God can do His will”?)

III. God’s Provisions and Promises (v. 10-12)

- A.) Old things pass away, behold all things become new
- B.) Outpours of provisions from God’s enemies
- C.) Obedience and promise of God = Blessed

(God promised He would go ahead of Joshua if he remained obedient)

IV. God’s Presence is with His People (v. 13-15)

- A.) Jesus Christ pre-incarnate
 - 1. He allowed Joshua to worship Him
 - 2. Jesus commanded it was Holy ground
- B.) Joshua had lived according to the command and will of God and was Holy and righteous before the Lord Jesus Christ
 - 1. Will we stand in Jesus presence or humbly bow
 - 2. Will we be found faithful or faithless
 - 3. Will our lives be Holy that we might worship at the feet of Jesus or will we compromise with the word and be separated.
